AN ORDINANCE OF PALMER TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING AN OMNIBUS AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 190 OF THE PALMER TOWNSHIP CODE WHICH: **PROHIBITS FEATHER** FLAGS: REVISES TEMPORARY REGULATIONS AND PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS; MODIFIES ZONING PERMIT PROCEDURES AND ZONING HEARING BOARD NOTICE REQUIREMENTS; REVISES AND ADDS DEFINITIONS; DESIGNATES THE ZONING OFFICER AS THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR; MODIFIES THE PERMITTED KEEPING OF JUNK VEHICLES, COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, AND FOOD TRUCKS; REVISES SIGHT DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS; ADDS REGULATIONS FOR PRIVATE SWIMMING POOLS; CREATES USES AND REGULATIONS FOR AUTO REPAIR GARAGE USE, GASOLINE SERVICE STATION USE, KENNEL USE; PROVIDES FOR SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE FIVE DAYS AFTER ENACTMENT.

Notice is hereby given that the Palmer Township Board of Supervisors will consider for possible adoption an Ordinance, of which this notice is a summary, amending Chapter 190 of the Palmer Township Zoning Ordinance by prohibiting feather flags, revising temporary sign regulations and permitting requirements; modifying administrative procedures and timelines for zoning permit review, revising definitions, designating Zoning Officer as Floodplain Administrator, modifying the permitted keeping of commercial vehicles, revising sight distance requirements, adding regulations for private and non-household swimming pools, and creating uses and regulations for auto repair garage use, gasoline service station use, and kennel use. The Board will consider the Ordinance and hold a public hearing at its scheduled meeting on Tuesday, September 15, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., in the Palmer Township Municipal Building, 3 Weller Place, Palmer, Pennsylvania 18045.
