Palmer Township recently began the process of developing a new, community-driven master plan for the Township-owned parks & trails along the Bushkill Creek Greenway Corridor. The primary goals of this plan are to:

- Mitigate flooding
- Update facilities
- Demonstrate exemplary accessibility
- Enhance multi-user recreation experience
- Support trail system changes
- · Protect habitat & enhance resilience
- Communicate local historic & cultural significance

Palmer Township is leading the plan with Omnes, a landscape architecture & planning firm based in Easton, whose consultant team includes Wildlands Conservancy and AKRF. This multidisciplinary team has expertise in landscape architecture & planning, resiliency, ecological restoration & engineering.
