NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED DISSOLUTION OF THE ROUTE 33 NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of Palmer Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 6, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Palmer Township Municipal Building, 3 Weller Place, Palmer Township, PA 18045, to consider the proposed dissolution of the Route 33 Neighborhood Improvement District ("District") and its associated Neighborhood Improvement District Management Association ("NIDMA"), pursuant to the Neighborhood Improvement District Act, 73 P.S. §§831-840.

The proposed dissolution is being considered following receipt of a written request endorsed by at least forty percent (40%) of the assessed property owners, in number, located within the District, as required under 73 P.S. § 838(b). The Board of Supervisors will hear testimony and receive public comment regarding the merits of the proposed dissolution.

If the Board of Supervisors approves the dissolution, a resolution to that effect will be filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth, and upon approval, the Route 33 Neighborhood Improvement District and its Management Association shall cease to exist. Interested persons are invited to attend and participate in the hearing. Written comments may also be submitted to the Palmer Township Manager at the address listed above no later than October 3, 2025.
