Curbside Single-Stream Recycling

Place the following items in your recycling cart (with the yellow lid) for weekly collection:

- **Plastics** – rinsed #1 through #7, no polystyrene foam. Attach lids.
- **Glass** – rinsed clear, brown and green bottles and jars. Discard lids.
- **Metals** – rinsed aluminum, tin and steel cans, and household metals, pots and pans.
- **Paper** – office, colored, and school paper, newsprint, junk mail, paper bags, phone books, magazines, catalogs, envelopes, wrapping paper (no metallic or bows).
- **Cardboard** – shoe, gift, and cereal boxes, corrugated boxes, cut or flattened as needed
- **Food and beverage cartons** – milk, cream, egg substitutes, orange juice, soup, broth, and wine cartons, and juice boxes
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS OR FOOD CONTAMINATED PIZZA BOXES**

Twenty-eight daylily plants, three bleeding heart plants, one Russian iris plant and seeds, six ornamental grass plants, black-eyed Susan's seeds, and hibiscus seeds were planted at the Fairview Park/bike path and Post office/ bike path gardens during the spring of 2017.

There has been some rain as of 5.21.2017 to help with root development of these plants. Gallons of water were transported to supplement the plant growth.

During the spring of 2016 a Palmer resident donated multiple sections of a Japanese sprigson bush. The plant has a shallow root system.

Even with watering it multiple times a week the plants did not flourish in the spring of 2017. People who frequent the bike path are encouraged to adopt some plants and help them grow by watering them.

Performing manual chest compressions of high quality is both difficult and tiring, and impossible in certain situations. The main speaker at our March luncheon was A.J. Schwartz, Managing Principal of Environmental Planning and Design (EPD), which is a planning firm based in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Early 2016 the Palmer Township Board of Supervisors voted to move forward with the update to the township's comprehensive plan, which is typically completed every ten years. Out of several proposals that were reviewed by a selection committee, the group chose EPD. Since June 2016, many meetings have been held with the steering committee, and several stakeholders in the township, to gather data necessary for the development of the updated comprehensive plan. The next step in the process was to present the results of the data to the public at a public meeting that was held the evening of March 15 at the Charles Chrin Community Center of Palmer Township. With the comments received from the public from that meeting, along with data gathered through surveys, and township wide observations, A.J.'s next step will be to begin the development of the actual updated plan. The completed project will be presented to the Board of Supervisors this summer for their review and approval.


New Pickleball Courts at Fairview Park
