Robert Fehnel made a motion to approve the minutes from April 6, 2021. The motion was seconded by Margie DeRenzis and the minutes were approved by a vote of 3-0.

The second proposed use would be a full-service hair salon. This property is in a Heavy Industrial Zoning District within the William Penn highway Overlay District.

Action: Margie DeRenzis made a motion to approve the application for a salon on the second floor of the building since the required parking for both businesses was able to be met.
